Rachel Bagshaw Director

Rachel is incoming Artistic Director at the Unicorn Theatre where stage work includes: *The Bee in* Me and Aesop's Fables. Work for Unicorn Digital includes Greeks Unplugged, Let Loose and Grimm Tales. She is also currently Associate at the National Theatre as a Peter Hall Bursary recipient 2022 – 24. Other theatre credits include: *A Dead* Body in Taos (Fuel), Augmented (Told by an Idiot); Midnight Movie (Royal Court); The Shape of the Pain (BAC / UK tour); Icons (WOW Festival, Hull); Resonance at the Still Point of Change (Unlimited Festival, Southbank); The Rhinestone Rollers, Just Me, Bell (Graeae). Film work includes BBC Culture in Quarantine commission Where I Go When I Can't be Where I Am. Rachel has directed extensively for drama schools and participatory projects, including A Midsummer Night's Dream for RADA and Hamlet for the Young Vic.
